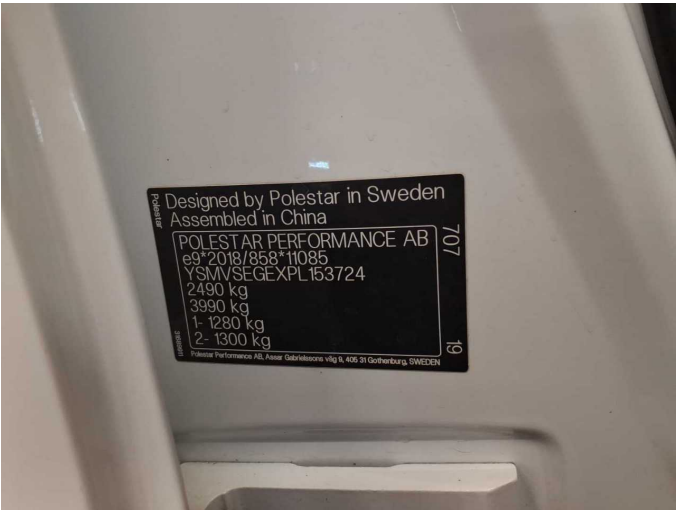


Figure 11: VIN

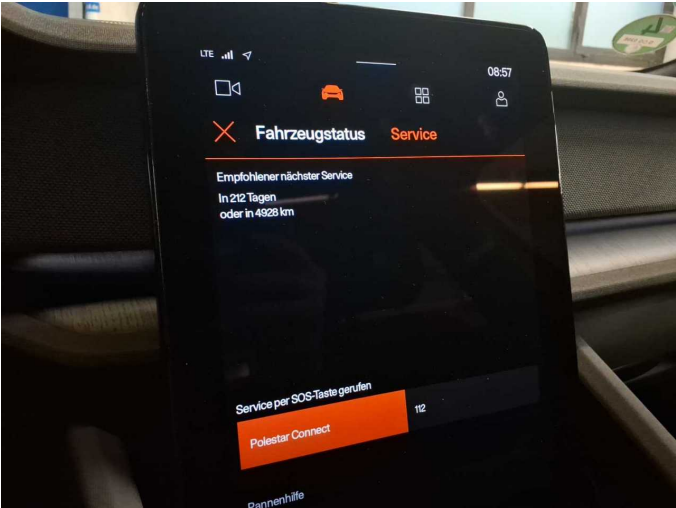


Figure 13: Documents

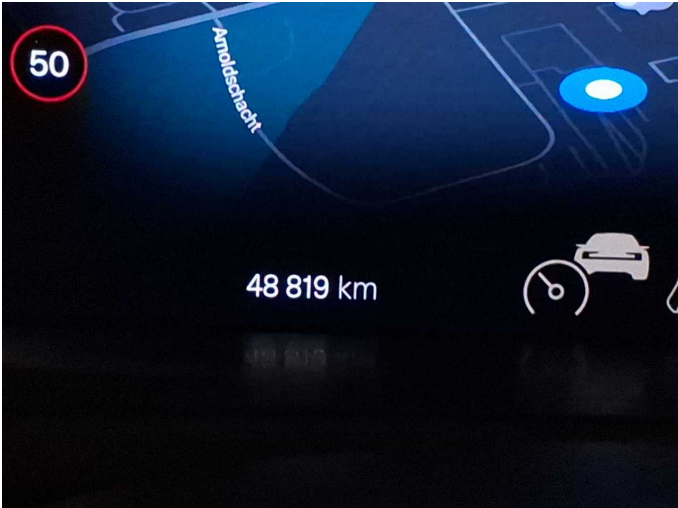


Figure 14: Documents

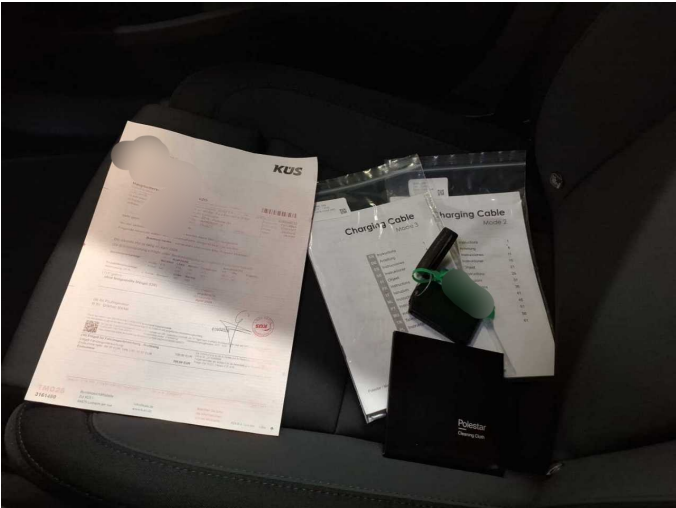


Figure 15: Documents

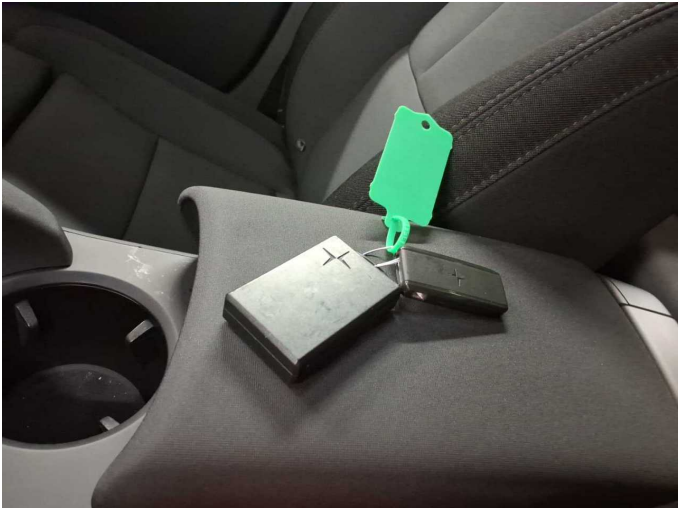


Figure 16: Documents

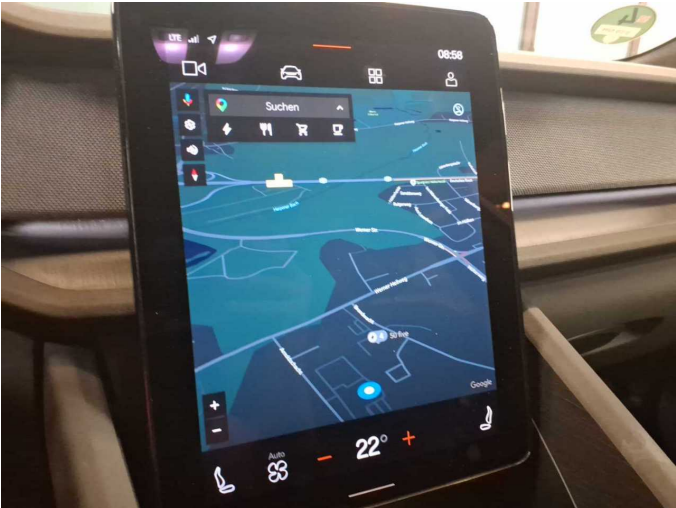


Figure 19: Navigation

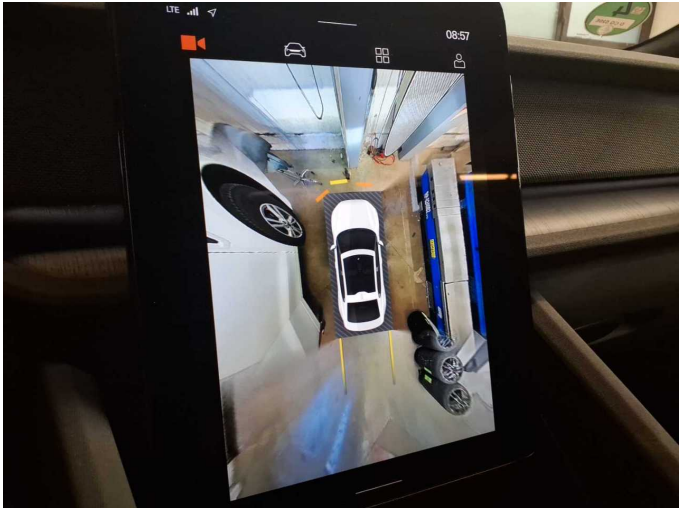


Figure 22: Misc.

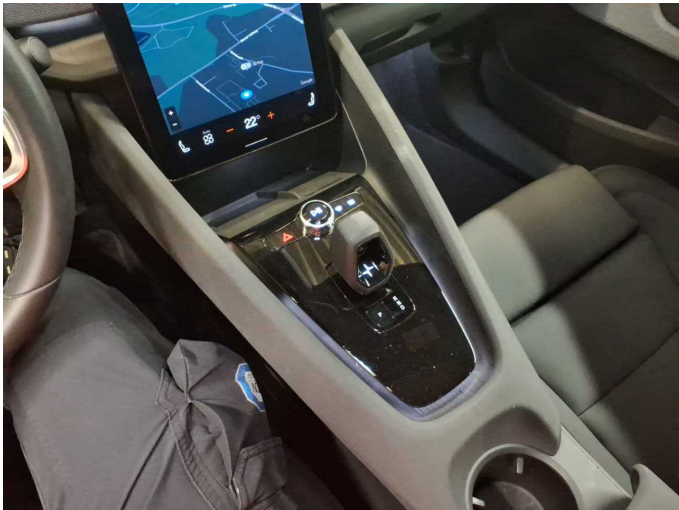


Figure 24: Misc.

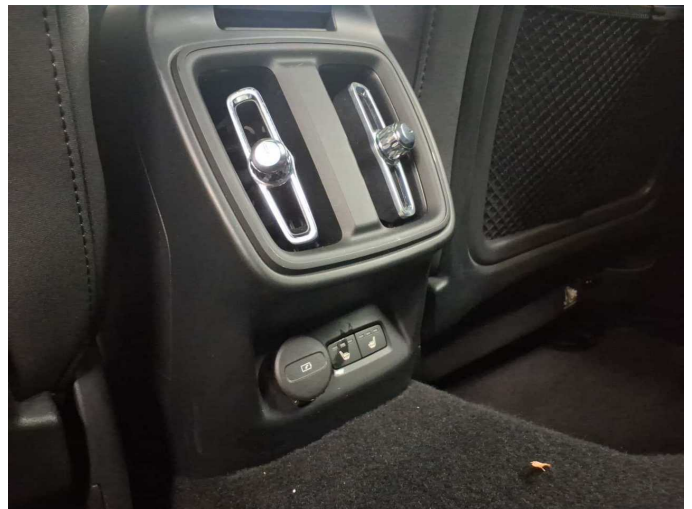


Figure 28: Misc.

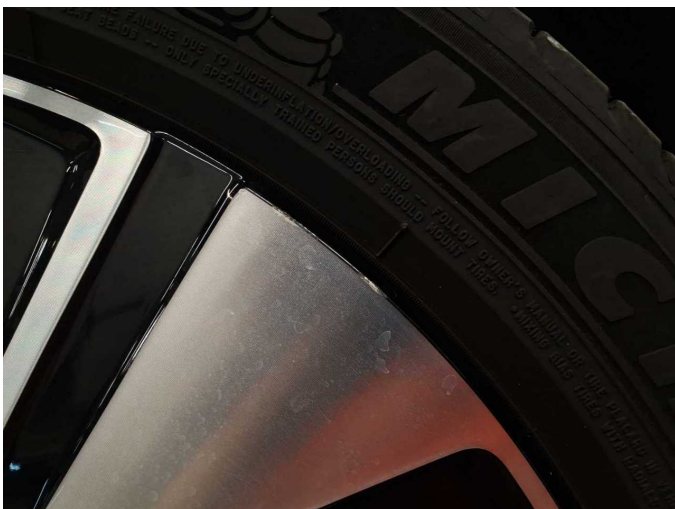

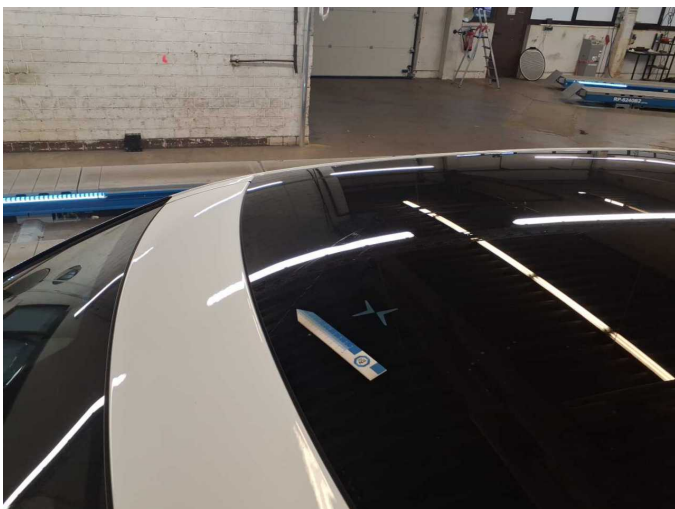
