Basis for the order

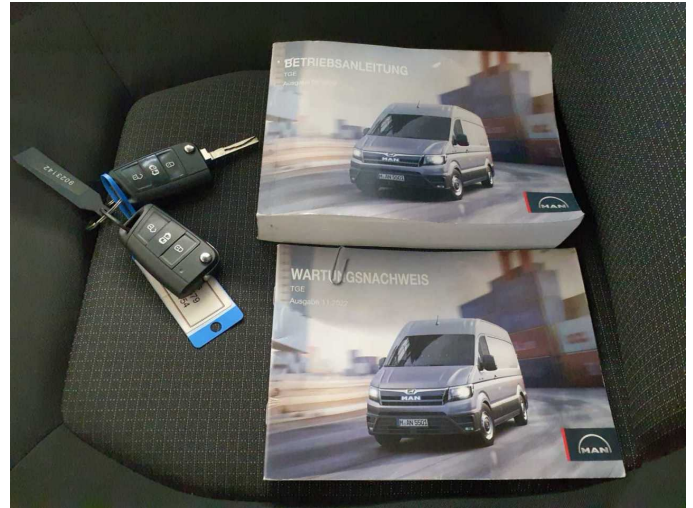


Figure 14: Documents

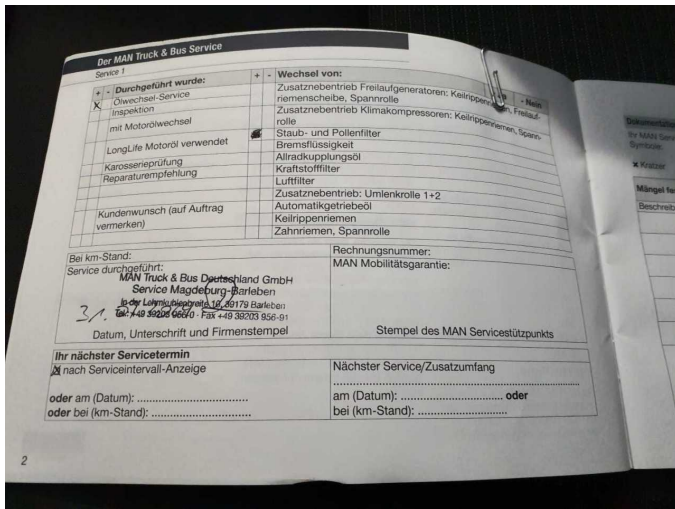


Figure 15: Documents

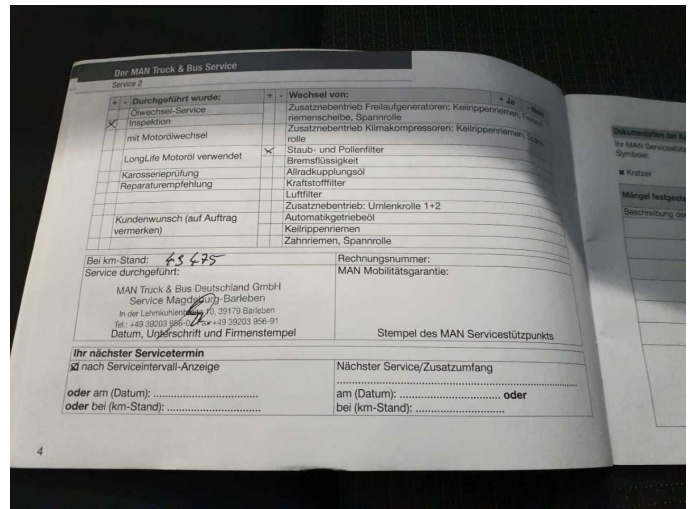


Figure 16: Documents
